- Whānau show an interest in our Whare Ora Programme.

Eligibility

- Confirm Registered with TST and legal homeowner (LINZ) or for whenua Māori, written documentation (LTO or OO).
- Complete Online Registration - sign disclosure and consent form.

Assess

- Our assessor will visit home your property and assess the health of your home.
- We provide real-time education around Healthy Home Performance and advice on how to maximize the health of your whare.

Report

- We create a detailed report of the findings including what meets Healthy Home standards and any maintenance or repairs noted and share external information links to support findings.

Prioritise

- Actions are prioritised by need and urgency. Together we work out what can be done as a whānau and where you need professional help.

- Based on your plan, we support you to take action with:
